

# MK DONS FC SPECTATORS' CODE OF CONDUCT.



By entering Stadium MK, you are agreeing to follow our Code of Conduct

If you do not follow these directions, or the EFL Ground Regulations at all times, you may be asked to leave the stadium. This is to ensure public safety, to protect you and your family or social bubble, other spectators, and staff working within the stadium

- It is critical that everybody observes the following key behaviours:
  - **HANDS** – Wash your hands regularly and for at least 20 seconds.
  - **FACE** – Wear a face covering at all times when inside Stadium MK (unless you have a pre-approved exemption notified to stewards on entry).
  - **SPACE** – Stay 2 metres apart from people you do not live with, where possible, or 1 metre with extra precautions in place e.g. wearing face coverings.
- You must not meet with people from other households in groups of more than 6.
- Stadium gates will open 90 minutes before kick-off. Please arrive in enough time to go through all necessary entry procedures.
- Please only use the entry gate specified on your ticket.
- Please bring photographic ID or a copy of photographic ID with you. Admission may be refused without this.
- A non-invasive temperature test will be carried out, and recorded, before you may enter the stadium. If your temperature indicates 37.8 degrees or higher after several tests you will be denied entry to the stadium.
- You must wear a face covering at all times, including when sitting in your seat and moving around in the stadium (unless you have confirmed an exemption in entry).
- Be aware that all payments inside the ground are contactless. Cash will not be accepted within Stadium MK
- You should use the amenities such as toilets, kiosks and bars that are designated on your ticket, where applicable.
- You should remain seated as much as possible.
- You may not change seats to another location, so please dress for the weather.
- If you do need to leave your seat, wait for a time when the aisles are clear and always follow the signs indicating which way to go. Do not travel against direction arrows or signs.
- When moving past other spectators turn your face away from them. This is called 'The Brush Past'
- Practice frequent hand hygiene, wash or sanitise your hands frequently. Avoid touching your face or face covering, handles, railings etc. whenever possible.
- Please observe respiratory etiquette, always cover your mouth if needing to cough or sneeze.
- You should avoid physical contact; being close and face-to-face; and shouting or singing close to other people who are not within your social group.
- At the conclusion of the game, please remain in your seat until directed to leave by the stewards. This will help everyone to exit the stadium in a safe and socially distanced manner.
- Ensure that other members of your family or social bubble have read or understand these directions.
- Spectators must only purchase tickets for their own family or support bubble. You must not pass on or sell tickets to anyone else, whether by sale or otherwise.

**DO NOT ENTER** IF YOU HAVE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS – A HIGH TEMPERATURE, A NEW OR CONTINUOUS COUGH, A LOSS OR CHANGE TO YOUR SENSE OF SMELL OR TASTE
